Chesed 24/7 operates rooms in major hospitals in New York City, Upstate New York and New Jersey – and serves an astounding 100,000 meals each year, reaching many thousands of patients!





BEDSIDE MEALS

It's one of the ironies of life.

People who are unwell need nourishing meals – but the food they get in the hospital is unappealing and inadequate. Hospital food jokes aside, what's there to like about semi-defrosted scrambled eggs, day-old rolls, and overcooked string beans? Chesed 24/7 fills the void, by sending complete suppers and Shabbos meals to patients – and their caregivers! **Amazingly, we were able to get food to patients in some hospitals even during the COVID-19 crisis!**



AND SO MUCH MORE.

From patient advocacy to rides to the hospital, electronic lending libraries to medical equipment – Chesed 24/7 gives patients everything they could possibly need, and more. Pomegranate juice for cancer patients? Check. Mothers' milk for preemies? Check. And so much more. Chesed 24/7 isn't bound by typical boundaries. Because where there are people that care, there's everything. And Chesed 24/7 is Constantly Caring.

Being in the hospital with coronavirus on Pesach was worse than my worst nightmare. Don't ask me how, but somehow Chesed 24/7 sent Kosher L'Pesach food, and a Shabbos Box on Erev Shabbos and Yom Tov. It was my link to normalcy. **Now I'm giving back."**

I visit people in the hospital, and always know I can go to the Chesed 24/7 hospitality room and get hot soup, a Danish, or something else to tempt a patient. On Fridays, I see the Shabbos boxes.

I want to be part of this."

My sister has cancer. I'm with her a lot on Shabbos, and can tell you that when we open that box and set the little wheeled table near her bed, we both feel the atmosphere change. I'll never forget our joy when we opened a box one week and found a little note from a woman who had packed the box at a party last summer. I want to personally reach out to patients like my sister."

ONE COMFORT

A Coronavirus Story

"So how is it to be home?" Tzivi asked. From her perch on the recliner, her mother looked around the room and nodded slowly. Then this rock of a woman; the formidable principal who'd not so long ago silenced 600 rowdy teenagers with the sheer force of her glare, drew her breath in, shut her eyes tight and wept and wept.

Twenty one days in the hospital. She'd gone in with coronavirus before Pesach, and come out three weeks later looking like she'd been through a war. It would take days for her story to emerge.

"I was so alone," she said one day, and she grasped Tzivi's hand as if she'd never let go. "When I called for a nurse, it took nine hours for someone to come. Nine hours! I was helpless! I couldn't do a thing for myself!" And Tzivi could only

imagine what it meant for her independent, go-getter mother to be at the mercy of nurses who never showed up. When she brought lunch, her mother started to cry again.

They brought me a treife tray, and the next day it was kosher chometz. A challah roll, on Pesach!

Delivery to Mount Sinai

"Remember how Bobby used to talk about how hungry she was in the ghetto? I never understood her, but now I do. The hunger was terrible. It was in a way worse than anything else I was going through – and I was going through a lot. I craved food so badly, it took over my whole being. It was terrible." Another day, she spoke about Pesach.

"For three days, all I had was the Chesed 24/7 bag that the Hatzalah member put on my stretcher." She described the simple white bag that had sustained her in a world gone haywire.

"It had matzah, grape juice, a water bottle, and some snacks. That's all I had. For three days. I couldn't eat anything from the hospital tray. One day they brought me a *treife* tray, and the next day it was kosher *chometz*. A challah roll, on Pesach! But I had the matzah from the bag. It was my only *taam* of Yom Tov." And then one day, she said, things suddenly got better.

"I started getting a bag every day. There was real *heimishe* food – a meal, a sandwich, a Danish – and a magazine. Do you know what it meant to me to get something to read? You know me. I can't eat breakfast without a newspaper. And all this time, I had been reading labels out of sheer boredom. I read the label on the grape juice bottle from the bag I got in the ambulance, and the information on every shopping bag that came to me. It was all from the same place.

Chesed 24/7."

Chesed 24/7 was a lifeline to patients and their families during the COVID-19 pandemic. Calling on long-standing relationships with hospitals, we were able to achieve the impossible. Our volunteers stocked ambulances with patient care packages, our drivers delivered food to hospitals, our patient liaisons helped families get patient information - and much more. When the restrictions were lifted, we stocked our hospitality rooms, so that the sick and their family members could get much needed substance and comfort. Today, a significant number of our 21 rooms are open again, dispensing food and essentials 24/7.


