OUR MISSION

Chai4ever preserves family functioning and mitigates the potentially devastating impact of serious parental illness. Our many programs target every aspect of family life, from practical to emotional to financial. These include:



CASE MANAGEMENT No matter the need, every Chai4ever family knows that they can reach out to their dedicated case manager. Each case manager is a licensed social worker, allowing for all practical and emotional support to be coordinated and implemented by one professional.



BIG BROTHER/BIG SISTER MENTORING When a child needs extra attention, a weekly outing with a handpicked mentor is exactly what the doctor ordered.



HOME HELPERS Who directs mealtime, bedtime, and playtime when mom is in the hospital? Caring home helpers arrive armed with a smile and determination to keep the home running.



FAMILY FUN DAYS When a parent is critically ill, time, energy, and money for a much-needed family vacation are always in short supply. We book an exciting venue with activities that appeal to all ages, and provide a full-service experience including gourmet food, helpful volunteers, and full wheelchair accessibility.



CAMP4EVER! Camp4ever! is a no-cost traveling camp that offers a haven amidst the turbulence of illness. Every child is nurtured by a one-on-one counselor, meets peers who “get it,” and has enough fun to re-energize him for the tough year ahead.



HOUSEKEEPING ASSISTANCE A clean home is a calm home. When a parent is incapacitated due to treatment or surgery, cleaning help is a necessity, not a luxury. Our cleaning assistance fund for families in crisis keeps the home running even when finances are tight.



MEAL PROGRAM Whether homemade or takeout, just on treatment days or daily, our hot meals warm the heart. When the kids want Mom’s food only, we’ll send a personal chef to make Mom’s recipes in Mom’s kitchen.



TRANSPORTATION Need a ride to treatment? A friendly driver will drive a patient around the block or across state lines, and join the patient for the appointment, too, if desired.



INSURANCE ADVOCACY When the cost of surgeries and medications become unbearable, our skilled insurance advocacy team negotiates on the patient’s behalf to ensure that essential treatments are adequately covered.



CRISIS INTERVENTION When a tragedy occurs, Chai4ever’s crisis team dispatches to homes, schools and communities to mitigate the traumatic impact via therapeutic interventions for every age group.
